

A BATCH OF AUTONOMOUS CALLATIAN COINS DISCOVERED AT ADAMCLISI, CONSTANȚA COUNTY

ABSTRACT

In the year 2002, between the monument and the ancient city of Tropaeum Traiani, a batch of four Callatian autonomous coins was discovered accidentally. There are three bronze autonomous coins of the Dionysos type, and one forged from the same metal, of the Apollo type. The discovery, although fortuitous, offers new data concerning the possibility to accumulate some small deposits or, rather, the probability that we could find ourselves in front of same items that were, at a certain moment, in the possession of a person who belonged to the merchant's sphere.
